

Maths : Year 1: We will look at place value, addition and subtraction. Children will learn to use the inequality symbols when comparing numbers. We will find one more and one less, order and compare numbers.

Year 2: We will look at place value, addition and subtraction. Children will recognise tens and ones, partition numbers and order numbers.

Computing: In computing we will be looking at what is a computer. We will explore exactly what a computer is by identifying and learning how inputs and outputs work, how computers are used in the wider world and designing our own computerised invention.

PHSE:
In PSHE we will be looking at our mental health and wellbeing. We will look at all the things that we can do to stay healthy mentally.

P.E: Children will be learning new skills in gymnastics. We will practice our skills and make a routine.

English: This term we will start off by writing sentences and learning about the four different sentence types. (Command, statement, exclamation and question). We will also look at a range of non fiction texts. We will learn how to write instructions, labels, lists and signs.
