

MATHS:

- Reading and writing numbers.

LITERACY:

Fiction (story opening): We will be looking at how to develop atmosphere in our writing, working on character description and then moving on to writing the opening to a story about finding a life-changing mysterious object.

Non- Fiction (film review): After reading a class novel, we will be writing a review to share our thoughts on the book.

ICT:

We will be exploring 'big data', we will look at how barcodes and QR codes work, and discuss how infrared waves are used for the transmission of data.

PSHE:

For this unit on 'health and wellbeing' we will be discussing risks in terms of legal and illegal drugs.

OAK CLASS TERM 1

GEOGRAPHY:

This term we will be 'investigating coasts'. We will be looking at the landscape of coasts, including different physical features, such as caves, arches, stacks and beaches. We will explore how they are formed and look at the advantages and disadvantages of living in a coastal area.

SCIENCE:
