

Communication and Language

- Confidence to speak in front of others
- Present to an audience with confidence.
- Increase effective use of tenses
- Express ideas and opinions related to topics, books read or key events.
- Taking turns when speaking in the role play area and building vocabulary.

Literacy

- Comprehension skills- listen, repeat and re-tell stories.
- Write phonetically plausible simple sentences and phrases.
- Guided reading sessions – work on Inference and Prediction skills.
- Writing alternative ending for stories e.g. the gingerbread man gets away.
- Read fiction and non-fiction books
- Begin to write own stories, ensuring a clear beginning, middle and end.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Work and play cooperatively and take turns with others
- Continue to follow rules and understand different boundaries.
- Discuss strangers in fairy tales-should we trust them? Introduce the children to the importance of stranger danger.
- Well-being and cultural diversity
- Set goals for the future and prepare for the transition into Year 1.

Mathematics

- Add single digit numbers
- Subtract single digit numbers understand what halving means and start to share objects that represent numbers.
- Write numbers 0 – 20 and beyond
- Compare two-time durations.
- Read a clock to the hour
- Doubling, halving, estimating and problem solving will all be a key focus this term.
- Read simple word problems.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Act out/ role-play fairy-tale stories
- Make our own outfits for favourite characters
- Decorate the fairy-tale castle
- Making houses for the 3 Little Pigs
- Textured collages.

Understanding The World

- Visit allotments and experience gardening / growing.
- Think about what we need to do in order for plants to grow.
- Create maps to and from different starting points e.g. through the woods, to the palace etc.
- Visiting different places on school trips.

Physical Development

- Blocks, piping, material etc. Children to make dens, castles, palaces, houses. Construction skills.
- Weekly PE lesson
- Moving with confidence around the school.
- Work in small groups to develop spatial awareness.
