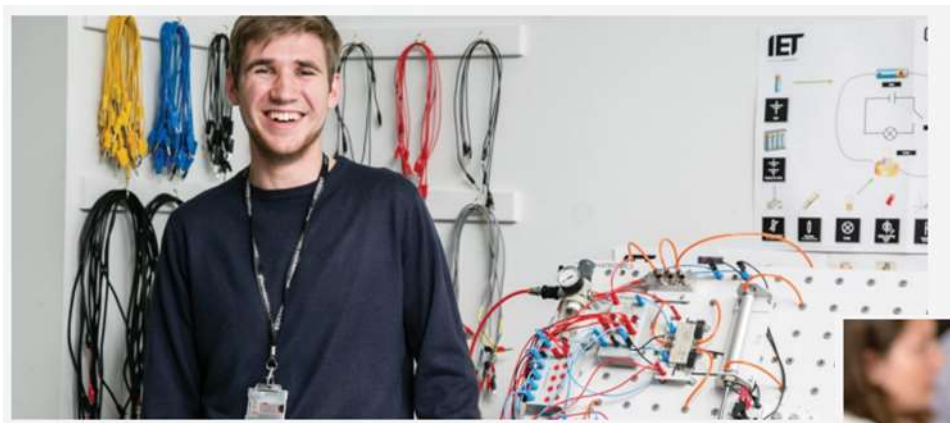

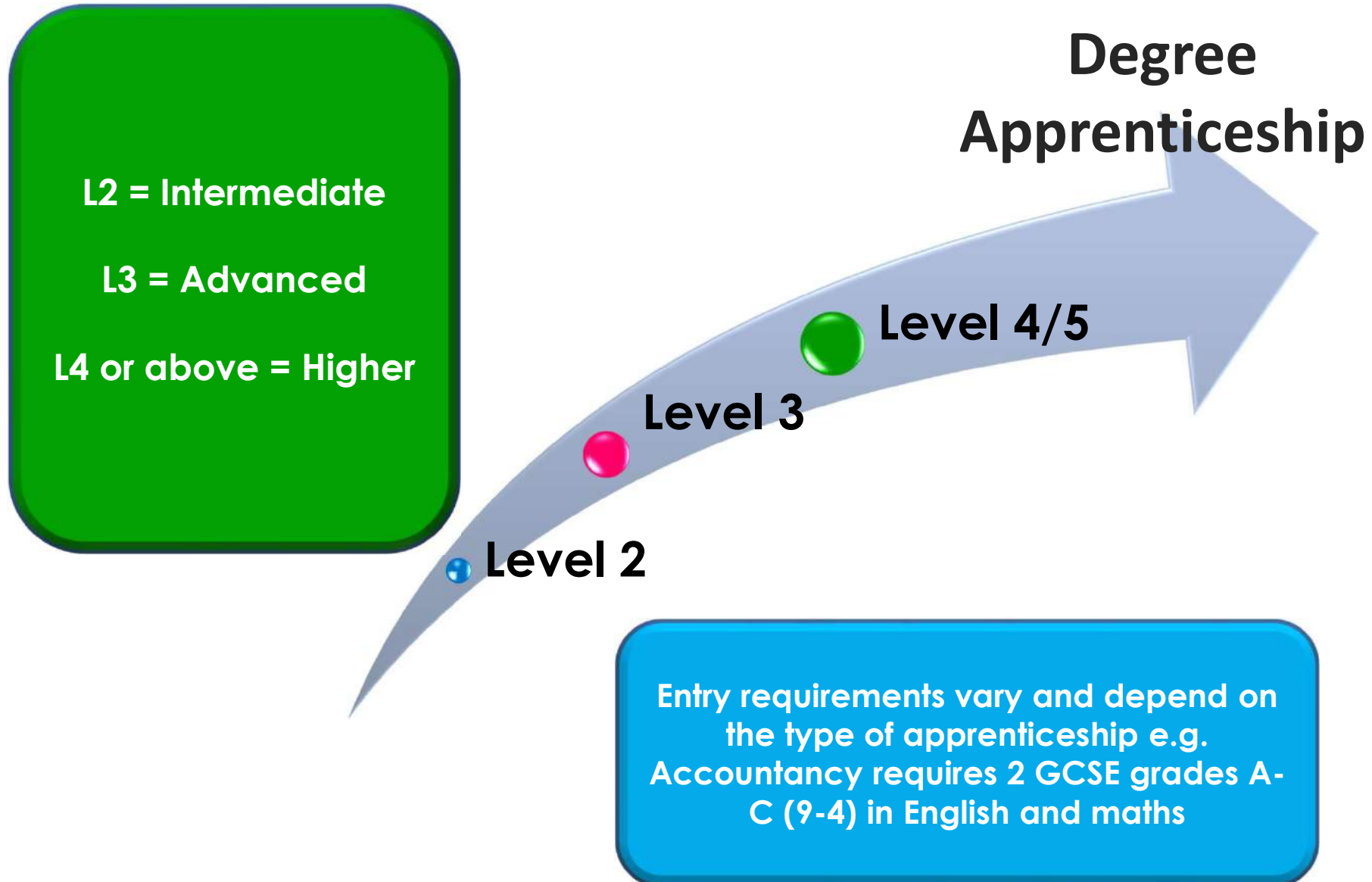

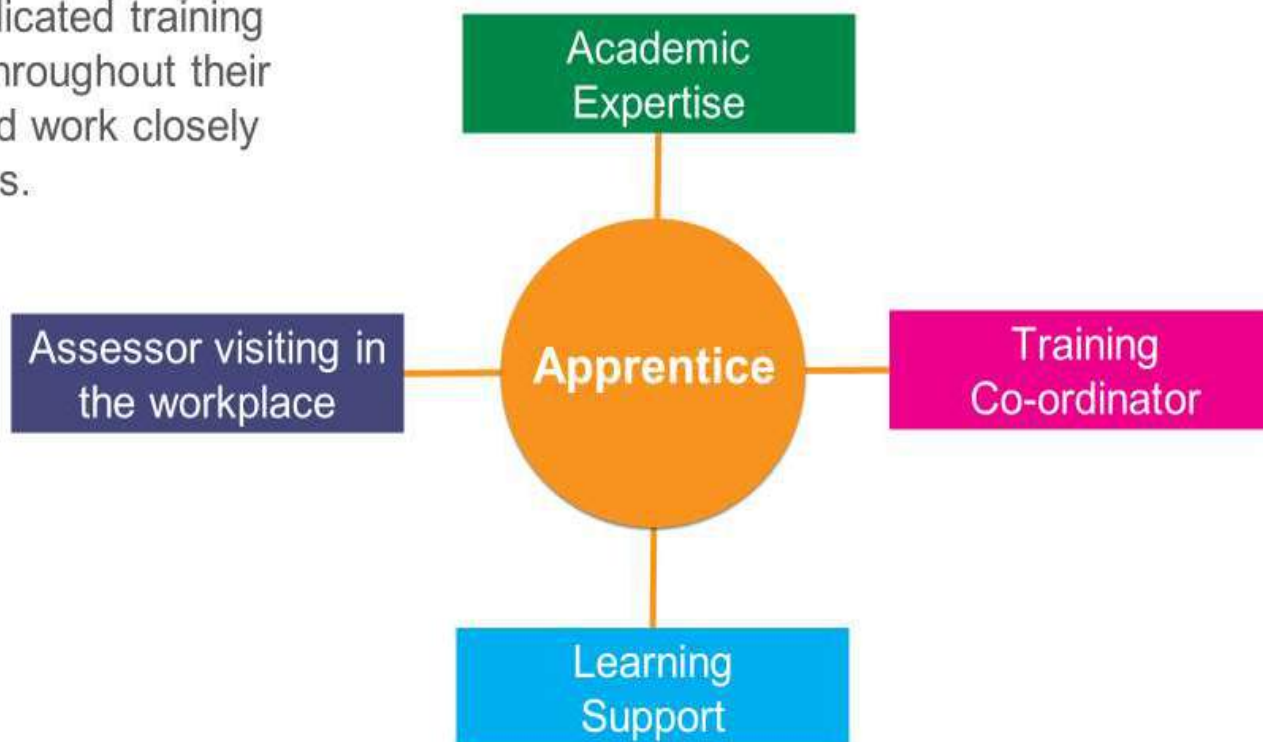

Apprenticeships

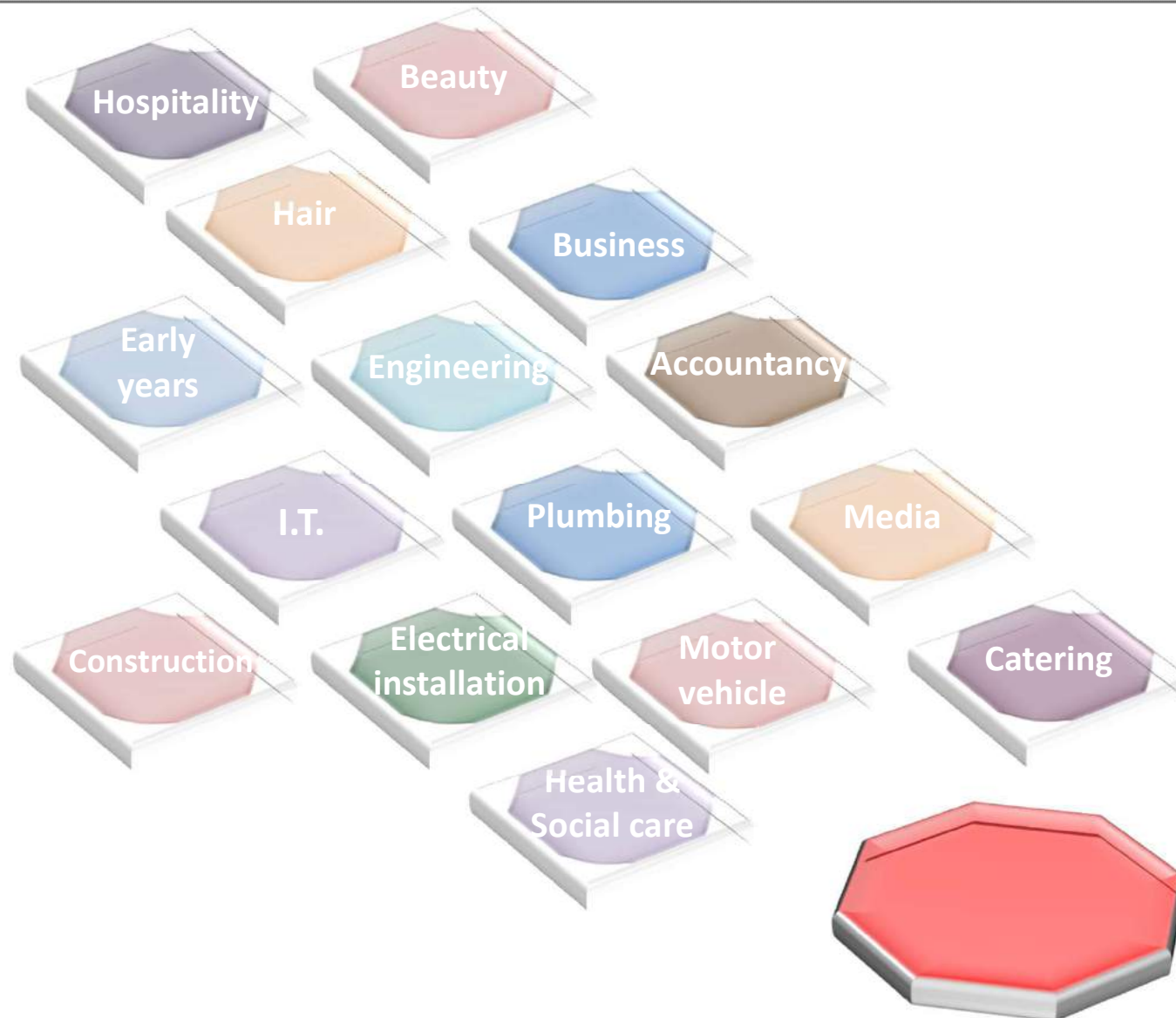
- Earn while you learn - minimum £3.90 per hour (*from April 2019*)
- Average wage £170 - £210 per week
- Can lead to a job
- Entry requirements vary, A* - C (9-4) for most pathways
- Study at College 1 day a week/4 days at work
- Delivered and assessed wholly in the workplace
- Available at intermediate, advanced and higher
- Gain nationally recognised qualifications – e.g. NVQS
- Also enables progression into further/higher education

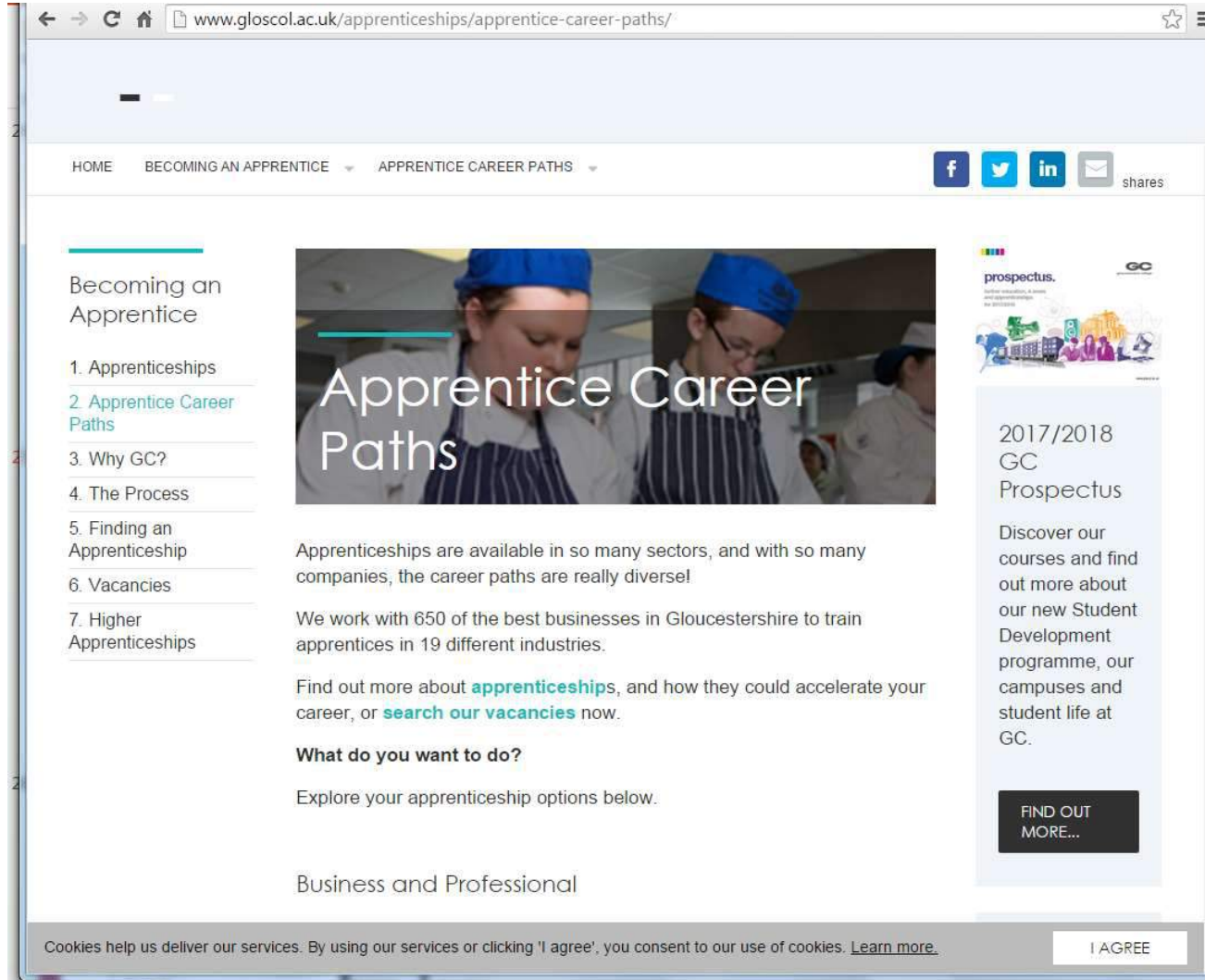
