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# What is education?

# Education in Europe

The European School system consists of two years of early education (nursery cycle), five years of primary and seven years of secondary education.

- **Is education free in Europe?**

All public colleges in Germany, Iceland, Norway and Finland are **free** for residents and international students. And some private schools in the European Union don't charge for tuition either. Many are going out of their way to attract foreigners by offering programs taught entirely in English.



## What is included in a European primary curriculum?

- **Primary school students will learn the following subjects:**
- **English Language.**
- Mother Tongue Language (MTL depending what country of Europe they are in)
- **Mathematics.**
- Science.
- Art.
- Music.
- Physical Education.
- Social Studies.

# What is included in a European secondary curriculum?

Secondary students are taught the following subjects:

- History.
- Geography.
- Modern foreign languages.
- Art and design.
- Music.
- Design and technology.
- Physical education (which must include swimming)
- Computing (often called information and **communication** technology or ICT)
