Week 2	Sex Trafficking	Sexual Exploitation Lover Boys and prostitution Rape and consent Taking a look inside Britain's shocking sex-trafficking crisis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students can describe the severe forms of mental trauma i.e.: PTSD caused through exploitation.</li> <li>• Students can differentiate between sexual consent and sexual assault.</li> </ul>
Week 3	Modern Day Slavery	To gain an insight into the world of: Forced Labour Bonded Labour Child Slavery Child marriage Descent-based slavery Domestic Slavery Slavery in supply chains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pupils know what to do if they believe someone is a victim of modern day slavery</li> <li>• Pupils will learn that Modern slavery affects people of every colour, age and gender – but is more prevalent among vulnerable people</li> <li>• Students are made aware that there isn't a single country that isn't tainted by slavery: 1.5 million victims are living in developed countries, with an estimated 13,000 enslaved here in the UK</li> </ul>
Week 4	Pornography Revenge Porn	Internet Safety  The impact of pornography on relationships, individual health, and society.  Revenge Porn – what it means for the victim and the offender  'Revenge Porn New Normal' after cases surge in lockdown.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pupils will develop an understanding of how the representation of sexual behaviour in books, pictures, motion pictures, and online have a negative impact on couples and gender relations, leading men and women to devalue one another.</li> <li>• Pupils will develop an understanding of how revenge pornography can result in lifelong mental health consequences for victims, damaged relationships, and social isolation.</li> <li>• Students are aware that a horrendous invasion of sexual privacy and personal space, in most cases occur at the hands of someone they love and trust.</li> </ul>
